For the next few weeks we will continue to develop our skills through our topic based around '**Our Locality**'. This topic will have a strong history, geography and science focus but will also allow for opportunities to explore all other areas of the curriculum.

During this time you will be expected to complete a two week homework project researching a part of the world that has links with Wales. From your research, you will need to prepare a short talk to present to the class. This talk will form part of your oracy assessment. Further details regarding this homework will follow on Google Classroom in the coming weeks.

For the second half of the Summer term, we will undertake work around **Global Goal Target No.1 – No Poverty**. The Global Goals are a plan agreed by all world leaders to build a greener, fairer, better world by 2030. Target No. 1 – No Poverty, focuses on ending poverty in all its forms, everywhere. We will look at poverty on a local, national and global level, looking at its causes and consequences and some of the ways in which we can work to combat it.
