Bring Your Own Devices (BYOD) Policy

Devices are brought into the school entirely at the risk of the owner and the decision to bring the device in to the school lies with the user and their parents/carers as does the liability for any loss or damage resulting from the use of the device in school.

The school accepts no responsibility or liability in respect of lost, stolen or damaged devices while at school or on activities organised or undertaken by the school.

The school recommends that the devices are made easily identifiable and have a protective case to help secure them as the devices are moved around the school. Pass-codes or PINs should be set on personal devices to aid security.

- **All devices must be clearly labelled**
- **All devices must only be used for reading. Any other use will result in the consequences listed below.**
- **All devices must be brought out from their bag at the beginning of the day and kept in the 'e-reader box' which each class will have, when not in use.**
- **Devices are not to be used at playtimes or lunchtimes.**
- **Devices are only for personal use and not to be shared.**
- **All downloads must take place at home, access to the school Wi-Fi network will be not be allowed.**

Consequences (for each instance of non-compliance)

- 1. The device will be sent home for one week.**
- 2. The device will not be permitted into school for two weeks and a red token will be given.**
- 3. The device will not be permitted into school for three weeks and two red tokens will be given.**
- 4. The device will not be permitted into school for the remainder of the year.**
